Roads Australia brings industry, government and communities together to lead the evolution of Australia's roads, integrated transport and mobility networks.

Roads Australia's members includes all of Australia's transport agencies, road owners, major contractors and consultants, material suppliers, service and technology providers, and other relevant industry groups.

Roads Australia upholds the principles of a safe, inclusive, sustainable, economic and socially valuable roads industry for all Australians.

Roads Australia strives to achieve a robust integrated transport system for people and freight that values and invests in all modes of land transport.

Diversity & inclusion

Leaders’ events

Single tables

Single tables are small informal Boardroom-style events, limited to 20-30 senior executives engaging in Chatham House Rules discussion with key government stakeholders on trending industry issues. These are free for members.

Board dinners

Board dinners are exclusive to Tier 1 members and Patrons who are invited to dinner with the RA Board immediately following Board meetings. Board Dinners are free for members and typically host 40-50 guests at EGM to CEO level.

Policy events

Transport summit

The Annual Transport Summit held in Sydney brings together over 300 leaders from overseas and across Australia to discuss prevalent policy issues across two days that are drawn from the Strategic Plan. The Summit also encompasses the CEO Workshop bringing 40 Tier 1 CEOs of industry together with transport agency CEOs nationally to discuss policy priorities and RA’s actions across each Policy Stream over the following 12 months.

Policy workshops

Policy Workshops are free for members and are predominantly hosted in Road Agency or member offices. These workshops consist of up to 120 members, and provide an opportunity to actively contribute as policy evolves and to network with other industry participants.

Networking events

Industry lunches

Industry lunches featuring high profile guest speakers are held regularly in capital cities across the country, attracting up to 450 attendees. These events offer an ideal opportunity for companies to book corporate tables and fly their company flags.

John Shaw Dinner

The prestigious John Shaw Gala Dinner is held on the first night of the Annual Transport Summit and attracts over 700 attendees each year as the industry’s premier event. The John Shaw Medal is awarded during the evening.

Annual lunches

Roads Australia holds Annual (Christmas) Lunches in capital cities across the country as a way to celebrate the festive season with members and invited guests. These are our flagship events attracting up to 550 guests in major cities. Guest speakers are generally state premiers and senior ministers.

Future leaders' programs

Emerging leaders

The Emerging Leaders program was introduced in 2016 for under 35’s to network, expand career horizons and entrench the ‘giving back’ philosophy among members. We seek to attract and retain a diverse and talented workforce and provide opportunities for mentorship and advice for Emerging Leaders.

Fellowship program

The Fellowship Program is a unique mentoring initiative that matches industry ‘up and comers’ with 10-15 years of experience with some of the most experienced, senior leaders in the Australian infrastructure sector. The Program focuses heavily on mentoring and leadership, and provides a strong sense of ongoing Fellowship with alumni opportunities and connection to the Emerging Leaders Program.


